



**Dansk Varmblod's
National Stallion Show 2010**
at Messecenter Herning 11 – 14 March, 2010

CONDITIONS

for

**Material & Regular Classes
in Dressage and Jumping**

The classes are open to stallions selected to Dansk Varmblod and to especially invited horses and riders. For further details, please see section 14 and 16.

Dressage Division

1. Dressage Material Class

Open to 4, 5, and 6-year-old horses. Plain snaffle bridle. Bandages allowed. Whip (not to exceed 110 cm for horses including lash) allowed.

10 minutes per 3 riders including entering and exit.

Class to be judged by 2 judges. Judged under saddle at Walk, Trot, and Canter. Three horses to be judged at the same time for 8 minutes followed by 2 minutes commenting by the judges.

Thoroughbreds, 4-year-old horses, 5-year-old horses, 6-year-old horses to be judged in separate heats according to age.

Horse and Rider to be judged on Walk, Trot, Canter, Rideability/Manners while shown, and as a Dressage Prospect.

Scale of Marks: 0-10. Half marks may be used.

In case of equality of points the competitor with the highest marks received under Dressage Prospect shall be declared the winner. In case of further equality of points the competitor with the highest marks received under Rideability/Manners shall be declared the winner.

4 year old horses can not be placed in this class, but will be commented.

2. Dressage Material Class

Open to 4, 5, and 6-year-old horses. Plain snaffle bridle. Bandages allowed. Whip (not to exceed 110 cm for horses including lash) allowed.

10 minutes per 3 riders including entering and exit.

Class to be judged by 2 judges. Judged under saddle at Walk, Trot, and Canter. Three horses to be judged at the same time for 8 minutes followed by 2 minutes commenting by the judges.

Thoroughbreds, 4-year-old horses, 5-year-old horses, 6-year-old horses to be judged in separate heats according to age.

Horse and Rider to be judged on Walk, Trot, Canter, Rideability/Manners while shown, and as a Dressage Prospect.

Scale of Marks: 0-10. Half marks may be used.

In case of equality of points the competitor with the highest marks received under Dressage Prospect shall be declared the winner. In case of further equality of points the competitor with the highest marks received under Rideability/Manners shall be declared the winner.

4 year old horses can not be placed in this class, but will be commented.

3. Dressage MB Figure Level

Open to 6 and 7-year-old horses. Plain snaffle bridle or simple double bridle. Bandages allowed. No whip allowed!

10 minutes per 3 riders including entering and exiting.

No points given. This class is only commented by the judge during the performance. No prize money.

Three horses to be judged at the same time. Must ride according to the judge's directions. Thoroughbreds will show as a separate team.

Must show: Medium and Extended Walk; Collected Trot including Shoulder in and Half Pass to the left and right and Extended Trot; Collected Canter including Half Pass left and right; Flying Change of Lead left and right and Extended Canter.

4. Dressage MB Figure Level

Open to 8-year-old and older horses. Plain snaffle bridle or simple double bridle. Bandages allowed. No whip allowed!

10 minutes per 3 riders including entering and exiting.

No points given. This class is only commented by the judge during the performance. No prize money.

Three horses to be judged at the same time. Must ride according to the judge's directions. Thoroughbreds will show as a separate team.

Must show: Medium and Extended Walk; Collected Trot including Shoulder in and Half Pass to the left and right and Extended Trot; Collected Canter including Half Pass left and right; Simple Flying Change of Lead left and right and Extended Canter.

5. Free Style MB Level

Open to 6-year-old and older horses qualified for this level. Plain snaffle bridle or simple double bridle. Bandages allowed. No whip allowed!

4-4½ minutes per rider.

Class may be split. Movements intentionally performed above MB level e.g. flying changes every fourth stride shall be penalized by elimination!

6. Free Style Prix St. George 2002 (free style for young riders 2009)

Open to 7-year-old and older horses qualified for this level. Simple double bridle. Bandages allowed. No whip allowed!

4½-5 minutes per rider.

Required Movements: Collected Walk (minimum 20 meters); Extended Walk (minimum 20 meters); Collected Trot including Shoulder in left and right; Collected Trot including Half Pass left and right; Extended Trot; Collected Canter; Collected Canter including Half Pass left and right; Extended Canter; Minimum 5 Flying Changes every Fourth Stride; Minimum 5 Flying Changes every Third Stride; Half-Pirouette carried out at Collected Canter left and right, Entering, Entering Parade, and Exiting Parade.

7. FreeStyle Intermediare I 2002 (revised 2009)

Open to 7-year-old and older horses qualified for this level. Simple double bridle. Bandages allowed. No whip allowed!

4½-5 minutes per rider.

The horse must have obtained at least 60% in previous Intermediare I classes.

8. Dansk Varmblod Free Style Intermediare II

Open to 7-year-old and older horses qualified for this level. Simple double bridle. Bandages allowed. Whip (not to exceed 110 cm including lash) allowed.

5-5½ minutes per rider.

Horse must have obtained at least 60% in previous Intermediare I or II.

Required Movements: Entering Parade, Collected Walk (minimum 20 meters); Extended Walk (minimum 20 meters); Collected Trot including Half Pass left and right; Extended Trot; Collected Canter including Half Pass left and right; Extended Canter; Minimum 7 Flying Changes every Second Stride; Minimum 5 Flying Changes every Stride; Half-Pirouette carried out at Collected Canter left and right; Piaffe (7-8 steps) visible inclination 1 meter is allowed; Transitions to and from Piaffe; Passage (minimum 20 meters), Exit Parade.

9. Free Style Grand Prix 1995 (revised 2009)

Open to 8-year-old and older horses qualified for this level. Simple double bridle. Bandages allowed. Whip (not to exceed 110 cm including lash) allowed.

5½-6 minutes per rider.

Horse must have obtained at least 60% in previous Intermediare I, II or GP.

Jumping Division

Friday:

11. Jumping Material Class

Open to 4, 5, and 6-year-old horses. 4-year-olds jump max. 1 m. and some jumps may be exclusively for 5- and 6-year-olds. 5- and 6-year-olds jump max. 1,20 m. The horses are commented by a judge during the performance. A total score is given for rideability / jumping manners. Scores between 0,0 and 10,0 are given. Competitors that have obtained an equality of points are equally prized/placed. Faults during the performance are judged as follows: Disobedience 1st time: 1,0 penalty point, Disobedience 2nd time: 2,0 penalty points, Disobedience 3rd time: Disqualification, Fall 1st time: Disqualification, Downstrokes: 0,5 penalty point, Exceeding of allowed time: 0,1 penalty point for each second thereof.

Lead brushing boots and Brazilian Boots are not allowed.

4 year old horses can not be placed in this class, but will be commented.

12. Jumping MB Method A

Open to 6 years and older horses

13. Jumping MA during the Gala Show

Method B1. Open to 6 years and older horses that are qualified to enter MB jumping (please see section 16).

After last entry, you will be contacted by the show committee, about your get-up. You find your dressing up yourself and it is at your own cost. Dansk Varmblod takes care of the music to you show.

The rider must wear a helmet during the whole ride. 2 minutes in total allowed at the arena inclusive of the actual competition ride. A max of 15 horses and riders is set, and the principle of "First come, first served" at the entering is practiced. Dansk Varmblod breeding sires have 1st priority. A max of two (2) horses per rider.

Saturday:

14. Jumping Material Class

Open to 4, 5, and 6-year-old horses. 4-year-olds jump max. 1 m. and some jumps may be exclusively for 5- and 6-year-olds. 5- and 6-year-olds jump max. 1,20 m. The horses are commented by a judge during the performance. A total score is given for rideability / jumping manners. Scores between 0,0 and 10,0 are given. Competitors that have obtained an equality of points are equally prized/placed. Faults during the performance are judged as follows: Disobedience 1st time: 1,0 penalty point, Disobedience 2nd time: 2,0 penalty points,

Disobedience 3rd time: Disqualification, Fall 1st time: Disqualification,
Downstrokes: 0,5 penalty point, Exceeding of allowed time: 0,1 penalty point for
each second thereof.

Lead brushing boots and Brazilian Boots are not allowed.

4 year old horses can not be placed in this class, but will be commented.

15. Jumping MA Method B1

Open to 6 years and older horses

16. Jumping SB during at the Gala Show

Method B1. Open to 7 years and older horses (please see section
16).

After last entry, you will be contacted by the show committee, about your get-up.
You find your dressing up yourself and it is at your own cost. Dansk Varmblod
takes care of the music to you show.

The rider must wear a helmet during the whole ride. 2 minutes in total allowed at
the arena inclusive of the actual competition ride. A max of 15 horses and riders
is set, and the principle of "First come, first served" at the entering is practiced.
Dansk Varmblod breeding sires have 1st priority. A max of two (2) horse per rider.

Sunday:

17. Jumping LA Method B4

Open to 5- and 6-year-old horses.

18. Jumping MB Method B4

Open to 6 years and older horses.

19. Jumping MA Method B1

Open to 7 years and older horses.

General regulations **for Dressage and Jumper Classes:**

1. Non-qualifying show. Show results will NOT be registered with DRF (The Danish National Equestrian Federation). DRF Rules and Regulations including revisions for 2010.
2. The show is offered with the permission of DRF.
3. A Ground Jury will be appointed first day of the show.
4. Dressage classes are judged by 2 or 3 judges. Indoor arenas building B and M are 20 x 60 meters. Bandages allowed in all dressage classes. Boots and overreach boots are not allowed in the dressage classes.

It is the responsibility of the competitor to select the appropriate music for the ride and present to the competition management a compact disc (CD) recording to be given to the announcer at least two (2) hours prior to the start of the class. The CD must clearly show time of ride, class number and name, and the name of the horse.

A tentative time schedule will be posted the day before the competition, and final time schedule will be posted two (2) hours prior to the class. Early classes (8:00 AM to 10:00 AM) will have final time schedule posted shortly prior to the closing of the show office the night before the classes.

REMEMBER: The horse owner has to be a full member of Dansk Varmblod to enter horses at the competition classes at the National Stallion Show in Herning.

Remember that it is important to report at the main secretary in arena F the day before your dressage classes and 2 hours before your show jumping classes.

5. Entries must be submitted using the attached entry form and reach the office of Dansk Varmblod no later than January 4th 2010.
6. Fees:
(fees include Danish VAT, stabling fee, and 2 admittance bracelets per horse)

Class Entry Fee	DKK 200,- per class/horse
Stabling Fee	DKK 2.775,- per stall
Refundable Office Fee*	DKK 1.000,- (no VAT)

*Refundable Office Fee must be paid for each horse at the same time as other fees, but on separate bank cheque (per horse) with no date written.

The check cannot be transferred to another horse. Check will not be deposited in bank, but will remain in Show Management's safety box and will be refunded when the horse has shown in all classes as specified on entry form. Refundable Office Fee will also be returned in case of documented illness of rider or horse.

7. Stabling: Stall(s) will be appointed at time of arrival (also see 18.)
8. Dansk Varmblod and Herning Hallerne A/S are not responsible for any horse or its participation in the show.
9. Dansk Varmblod and Herning Hallerne A/S are not responsible for any loss of tack or other equipment.
10. Bedding straw is available for initial bedding and throughout the show (do not bring any straw).
Owner/Rider is responsible for providing hay, feed, as well as buckets for water and feed, and shavings if necessary.
11. No horse may arrive prior to Wednesday March 10th 3:00 PM, and must depart no later than Sunday March 14th by 7:00 PM.
12. Show Management may at the discretion of Dansk Varmblod cancel or combine classes with no or too few entries.
13. Show Management may at the discretion of Dansk Varmblod split dressage classes with too many entries.
14. Only Dansk Varmblod stallions approved for 2010 may enter Material or Regular classes.
15. Prize money and sponsored prize gifts MUST be collected in the show secretariat on the same day of the class. Regarding the classes 13 and 16 at the latest on the day after. All classes are open according to qualifications mentioned under 16.
16. Horses and ponies can qualify for the National Stallion Show in Herning 2009 by participating in point-giving shows during 2008, 2009, and 2010 (months of January and February) as well as the National Stallion Show 2008 and 2009.

Dressage: Minimum 60% must be obtained in a class of similar level. However, 4-year-old horses do not need to qualify for classes 1 and 2. Each horse may enter no more than two consecutive levels.

Show Jumping: The National Stallion Show is open to horses with prior ribbon awarded results in classes of same height as classes entered at this

show. However, 4-year-old horses do not need to qualify for classes 11 and 14. 5-year-old horses do not need to qualify for classes 11, 14, and 17.

Please Note: Especially invited riders and horses may be invited to attend this show without prior qualification!

17. Each rider may compete with no more than 3 horses per class; however, only one horse per rider are permitted for the Show Jumping part of the Gala Shows.
18. All horses on show grounds must submit proof of current and updated vaccinations against the flu as well as current health certificate according to FEI regulations to the stabling personnel before unloading horse(s).
19. Horse owners with unsettled debt to Dansk Varmblod may not enter any horses or ponies at the National Stallion Show.
